Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated Adoption Policy

Thank you for your interest in adopting an equine from Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated. Please read the following adoption policy carefully. Please contact us if you have any questions.

- As part of the application process, prospective adopters must submit a signed adoption application including references.
- References will be contacted and interested adopters will be screened thoroughly.
- Adopters must be at least 18 years of age with proven financial stability to be able to financially support an equine. Anyone under the age of 18 must have an adult that will undertake full financial responsibility for the equine. Out of state adopters may have additional requirements with regards to Coggins testing, health certificates, visiting, providing safe/qualified transport and photo/video of facility.
- Adopters must agree in writing never to sell, trade, or transfer ownership to any other person or place without first offering first right of refusal to Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated. The equine must never be sent to auction, sold to a horse dealer or kill buyer or offered "for free" on any advertising medium.
- Adopters must be financially, legally, ethically, and morally responsible for the adopted equine. Enclosures must be appropriate and the adopter must provide regular veterinary and farrier care, appropriate nutrition and exercise.
- If for any reason, the adopter can no longer provide for the equine (during the life of the equine), Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated must be notified and offered first right of refusal to arrange return of the equine to Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated or to make other arrangements to rehome the equine. Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated will not be responsible for any encumbrances of any liens including feed liens.
- Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated reserves the right to provide life-long follow-up to adoptions. With prior notification, Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated may request a site visit at different intervals each year.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$300 is required to place an equine in "adoption pending" status and the total adoption fee of \$_____ is due prior to the equine's departure from Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated and must be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Adoption fees are neither non-refundable nor tax deductible.
- Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated has subsidized 2 to 6 months of training for every equine that is offered for adoption, however, some equines may continue to require additional professional training. Please let us know if you need a referral for a reputable trainer.

- Wild Rose Mustang Advocacy Group Incorporated must be notified immediately if an adopted equine dies or is humanely euthanized. A veterinarian's statement/cause of death is requested along with the permission to contact the veterinarian.
